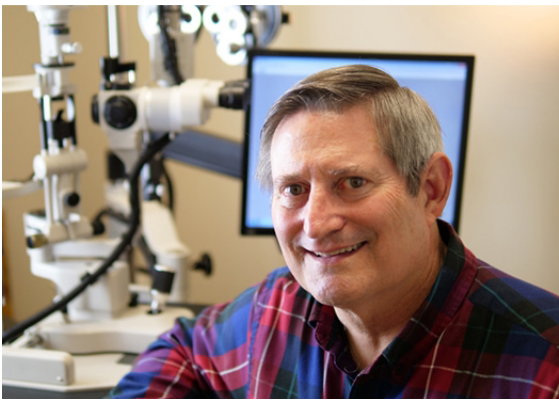




Dear Friends,
